- Implements digital tools and low-cost tech solutions to make learning engaging, inclusive, and accessible for all.

03 Support for Visually Impaired Students

- Develop audiobooks and accessible learning materials tailored to the needs of visually impaired students.
- Advocates for inclusivity in education by providing teacher training, awareness programs, and accessible resources such as audio libraries.

04 Life Skills and Career Counselling

- Equip adolescents with critical life skills for decision-making, communication, and emotional resilience.
- Offers career counselling sessions to guide students towards meaningful and sustainable livelihood opportunities.

05 Mothers' Counselling Initiatives

- Engages mothers in their children's educational journeys through counselling sessions to foster supportive home environments.
- Promotes dialogue on gender equality, mental health, and community well-being to empower families.

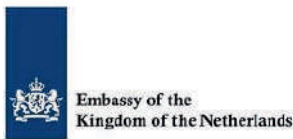
